Summary.	Harding Field was a training base for the United States Army Air Corps. The base was active from 1941 to 1945. The file is composed of materials collected by the staff of the base and by Col. W. G. Schauffler, Jr., the commanding officer at Harding Field from February 1944 to December 1945. The collection contains correspondence, news clippings, and photographs about Harding Field and the pilots who trained there.

BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE

History of Harding Field

Located nine miles north of Baton Rouge, the air base was originally intended to replace the Baton Rouge airport on Goodwood Boulevard. As the war effort began in earnest, it was instead used as a military installation for the United States Army Air Corps. Preliminary phases of construction began on March 17, 1941 and the first contingent of soldiers arrived on July 15, 1941. Official flag-raising ceremonies were held September 29, 1941 and the air base was officially designated as Harding Field on January 22, 1942. The base operated for four years, from 1941 to 1945. It was officially deactivated as a military base on March 28, 1945. There were three commanding officers at Harding Field: Col. L. L. Koontz (March 31, 1941-Oct. 4, 1943), Col. Bernard Castor (Oct. 9, 1943-Feb. 6, 1944), and Col. William G. Schauffler, Jr. (Feb. 20, 1944-March 1, 1945).

Biography of Col. William G. Schauffler Jr.

William G. Schauffler Jr. was born in Beirut, Syria on November 24, 1891. His father was an American doctor; his mother died in childbirth. His father remarried three years later and in 1896 moved the family back to the United States. Schauffler Jr. spent his formative years in New Jersey, finishing his college education at the Taft School, Yale University, and the University of Wisconsin before he enlisted in the Aviation Section of the New Jersey Naval Reserve in 1916.

For his performance in WWI, he was appointed Assistant Chief of Staff of the First Army Air Service, American Expeditionary Force and advanced to Chief of Staff. He was later promoted to Major and made Commander of the First Army Air Service in Europe. He married Augusta DeForest on Oct. 11, 1919 when he had returned from the war. His interest in aviation continued and on March 1920 Schauffler Jr. made the first intentional live parachute jump from an Army airplane to test a new parachute. A few months later, on July 12, 1920, his son, William G. Schauffler III was born. His daughter, Kate DeForest Schauffler, was born July 28, 1923.

At the outbreak of WWII, Schauffler Jr. was considered "over age" for full time duty. His son, however, immediately joined the Air Force; completing his pilot training program in Lake Charles, Louisiana at Louisiana's Esler Field in May 1942. A few short months later, on July 12, 1942, Schauffler Jr. was given a commission as a full Colonel and began his work as the commanding officer of several air bases: including Geiger Field in Spokane, Washington; Harding Field in Baton Rouge, Louisiana; and Peterson Field in Colorado Springs, Colorado. In July, 1943, while acting as the Commanding Officer at Peterson Field in Colorado, Schauffler Jr. was informed that his son, William G. Schauffler III had been shot down over the South Pacific and was officially considered "missing in action."

In February 1944, Col. Schauffler Jr. was transferred to Harding Field to act as the commanding officer. A few months later, he would be informed that his son, as of June 1944, was officially listed as "killed in action" by the Army.

History of the Harding Field Heroes File

The same month Col. Schauffler Jr. received confirmation of his son's death, he wrote to the next of kin of all the student pilots who came through the base, asking for any newspaper clippings, photographs, or information about the young men after they had left the base. He wanted to keep a record of the success of his troops and kept a running tally of the missions accomplished, honors and medals earned, and the numbers of those listed as "missing in action" or "killing in action." The result of his inquiry would be thousands of newspaper clippings and over 600 letters from next of kin. Col. Schauffler Jr. personally responded to each letter he received.

As the war effort was winding down, it was decided that Harding Field was no longer needed as an air base. It would close the following year on March 28, 1945. In order to preserve the legacy of his Harding Field men, Col. Schauffler Jr. contacted President Hatcher of Louisiana State University (LSU). President Hatcher agreed to keep the materials and establish a permanent exhibition under the title "Harding Field Heroes" in the War Memorial Tower of LSU. Next of kin were asked to send any future information, clippings, etc. to the Harding Field Heroes file under the care of President Hatcher at LSU. When the War Memorial Tower was converted into the LSU Museum of Art, the Harding Field Heroes File was transferred to Hill Memorial Library.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection includes the letters, photographs, and newspaper clippings sent by the next of kin of pilots who graduated from Harding Field. Materials originate from all across the United States. This correspondence was elicited from Col. Schauffler, Jr. upon learning of his own son's death. The collection also contains newspaper clippings about the air base from local papers and range in date from the establishment of the base in 1941 to its decommissioning in 1945. The collection also contains 51 photographs which include group photos of the pilots, individual portraits of officers, and photographs of pinning ceremonies. The lists that Schauffler, Jr. maintained of pilots killed or missing in action, decorations received, and planes shot down are also included. A painting of the "72 Fighter Wing" emblem is also present.

SERIES DESCRIPTIONS

Series I. Correspondence, 1943-1946, undated

This series contains correspondence in the form of letters, photographs, and newspaper clippings from next of kin, wives, mothers, and fathers of pilots who graduated from Harding Field. This correspondence was the direct result of Col. Schaufler, Jr.'s inquiry to next of kin for information about pilots' exploits once they had left Harding Field. The information sought included which decorations and how many the pilot had received, how many enemy planes the pilot had shot down, and whether or not the pilot was reported "missing in action" or "killed in action."

Series II. Photographs, 1941-1945

This series contains 51 photographs (40 of which are 20x24 inches, eight of which are 8x10 inches, one of which is 16x20 inches, one of which is 8x9 inches and one of which is 7 ½ x9 ¼ inches). The subject matter is mainly staged group photographs of the pilots, individual portraits, and photographs of pinning ceremonies. Of particular interest is a photograph of Col. Koontz, a signed photograph of Col. Schaufler, Jr. with an inscription to LSU, a signed group portrait with leaders of the base and a photograph of Lt. William W. Harding, for which "Harding Field" was named.

Series III. Printed and Graphic Materials, 1941-1945, undated

This series contains chiefly newspaper clippings from local Baton Rouge papers about the day-to-day operation of Harding Field. There is at least once clipping per day, with some days having as many as 10 clippings per day. The dates range from May 1941 through December 1944. The majority of clippings contain information about weddings, bridge games, and baseball scores. Infrequent clippings include information on deserters and criminal activity. A painting of the "72 Fighter Wing" emblem is also present.
